### Sample Questions

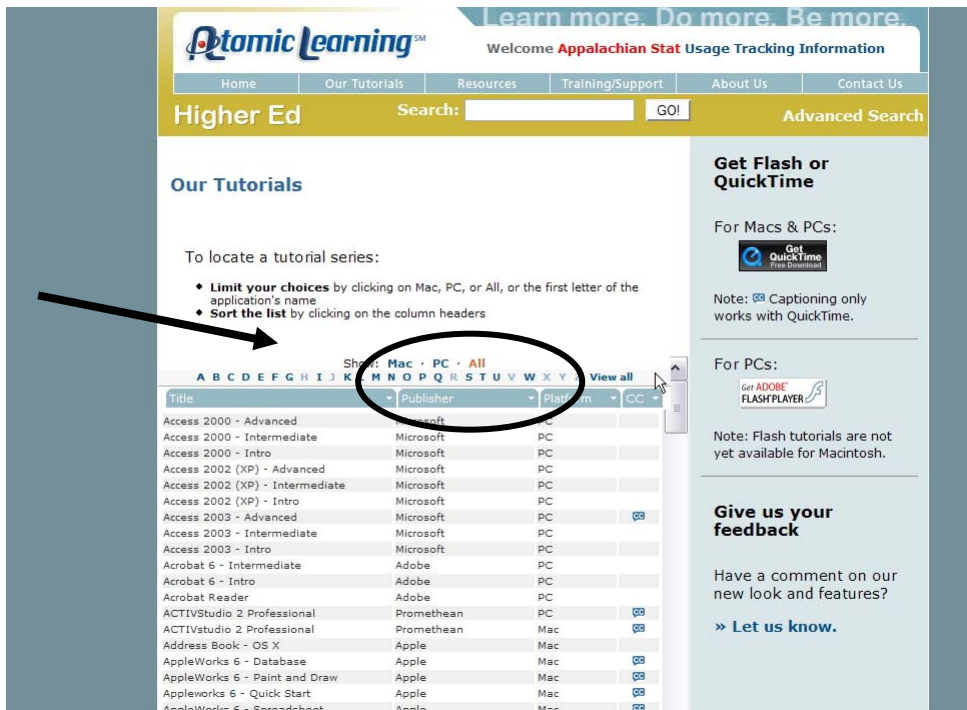
- How do you change page numbering in a Word document?
