

Vendor Permission to Videotape Presentation

In order that the Department may have a record of representations made by publishers' representatives, the Department conditions its permission for you to meet with the faculty on your consent that such meeting be video-taped. Further, the tape and the transcript will be a public record, available to anyone who wants it. N.C.G.S. § 132-1(a) defines "Public record" or "public records" as "all documents, . . . films, sound recordings, magnetic or other tapes, . . . regardless of physical form or characteristics, made or received pursuant to law or ordinance in connection with the transaction of public business by any agency of North Carolina government or its subdivisions."
